

Update from Mesa County Animal Services



Mesa County Animal Services (MCAS) staff continues to provide critical services to residents and the animals in our community. Shelter and community enforcement operations continue while operating under COVID-19 guidelines.

Animal Services is responding to calls for service on a priority basis, as we had before the pandemic. Our officers are wearing face masks when responding to in-person service calls.

As per direction from the Governor's Office, masks are required for entry into the Animal Services Facility, 971A Coffman Road in Whitewater. Mask will help keep our staff and visitors healthy.

Please help us keep our staff safe and healthy so they can continue to provide critical services to the community and to our shelter animals.

In other news, as we move toward spring, citizens are reminded that dogs are required to be leashed (10 feet in length or less) in City and County parks. The only off leash areas are the dog park inside Canyon View Park, the dog park inside Las Colonias Park, and on selected areas of BLM land.

As a reminder, dry dog food, canned dog and cat food, and non-clumping cat litter donations can be made during shelter hours and are VERY much appreciated!
